Shown below is some background information on the logistics for the upcoming **EYE CPPP, June 20-22, 2008**. Most of it is “for your information” only.

Once you have officially registered for the course, the only required action at this time is to call the hotel and make a reservation. Details below.

Arrive: Friday **June 20th, 2008**, afternoon/evening.
“Hangar Party/Reception” Friday 7 pm at the hotel conference room.
Spouses welcome! A detailed participant’s agenda for the entire weekend will be available at the FBO and the hotel upon arrival.

Airport: Eagle Creek Airport (EYE)

Host FBO: **Eagle Creek** is the FBO and will be our aviation host for the weekend.
Eagle Creek has fuel, tie downs and rental cars (if you require)

Eagle Creek (on site) is a Cirrus Service Center and will be providing maintenance services.

Flight option participants MUST bring their own plane! Two pilots may share a plane for individual flight training, but we need to know that in advance.

This is a nice hotel approx 4 miles from the airport. **Participants should call 317-297-7700 promptly for reservations and please mention the COPA Room Block.** Rooms for the block are \$114.00 a night plus taxes. Price includes full breakfast at the hotel. Our contact person at the hotel is Jenny Hagstrom if you have any hotel specific questions.
The cost of the hotel will be paid directly by the participant.

Transport: COPA will provide transport from the airport to the hotel on Friday from 2-6pm. Arrivals outside this slot can call the FBO to arrange transportation. Transport for the rest of the weekend will be announced during the Friday evening meeting.

Meals: Friday Night “Hangar Party” at hotel w/ finger foods.
Saturday and Sunday breakfast will be in the hotel restaurant.
COPA will provide a box lunch Saturday and Sunday.
COPA will provide a group dinner Saturday night 730pm — spouses invited. **The dinner will be located at Eagle Creek FBO.**

Simulator: Simulator slots for the CPPP will be assigned a couple of weeks prior to the course in the order in which folks registered for the course. If you are one of the first to register for the course, you will receive an email referencing the simulator in mid April.
